All donors will receive a \$10 Starbucks gift card for their blood donation.

Donors must:

- Bring a valid photo ID to the blood drive.
- Be in good health the day of the drive no COVID-19, cold or flu-like symptoms.
- Eat a healthy meal/snack and drink plenty of water before donating.

Do <u>NOT</u> donate if you:

- Have been diagnosed with, or are suspected of having, COVID-19 within the past 14 days
- Have <u>not</u> been fully vaccinated <u>and</u> live with someone, or have been in close contact with someone, who has tested positive or is suspected of having COVID-19 within the past 14 days. Otherwise, a COVID-19 vaccination is not required to donate.

Vaccination Update: We are now able to accept donors who have received the Pfizer, Moderna and Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine with <u>no</u> deferral period. Donors who have been FULLY VACCINATED with a Food and Drug Administration-authorized COVID-19 vaccine (at least two weeks from the last required dose of vaccine) can donate blood at any time, despite being exposed to COVID-19, if the donors do <u>not</u> have any COVID-19 symptoms.
