**Vaccination Update:** We are now able to accept donors who have received the Pfizer, Moderna and Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine with no deferral period.

Donors who have been **FULLY VACCINATED** with a Food and Drug Administration-authorized COVID-19 vaccine (at least two weeks from the last required dose of vaccine) can donate blood at any time, despite being exposed to COVID-19, if the donors do not have any COVID-19 symptoms.

**All City of Hope blood drives are socially distanced collection sites and are not mass gatherings.**

### **Donors must:**

- Bring a valid photo ID to the blood drive.
- Be in good health the day of the drive — no COVID-19, cold or flu-like symptoms.
- Eat a healthy meal/snack and drink plenty of water before donating.

### **Do NOT donate if you:**

- Have been diagnosed with, or are suspected of having, COVID-19 within the past 14 days
- Have not been fully vaccinated and live with someone, or have been in close contact with someone, who has tested positive or is suspected of having COVID-19 within the past 14 days. Otherwise, a COVID-19 vaccination is not required to donate.
