On October 26th 2008 founder Amy Wang of Azusa Lighthouse Mission was tragically run over by a 2000 Mercury Villager Family Van. It was a typical Sunday morning she was pulling into the drive way of the mission to give her usual Sunday Morning exhortation at the Mission. When she noticed a conspicuous person entering the mission of-

ficie. In an attempt to stop the individual she abruptly stopped her van in the middle of the Mission driveway not knowing that she had not fully placed her vehicle in Park but in Reverse. As she attempted to exit her vehicle the car began to roll back in reverse. Her body was halfway out of the vehicle when the vehicle door knocked her to the ground and the front driver side wheel

completely rolled over her right leg, abdomen, sternum, and arm. She was immediately hospitalized for 2 days. The doctors ran tests and x-rays to make sure there were no broken bones or internal bleeding and by the miraculous power of God the Doctors could not find any evidence of such.
