



Parent's Rules/Guidelines

1. Have Class Rules

CLASS RULES

- 1. Raise your hand before you talk.
- 2. Keep your hands to yourself.
- 3. Clean up after yourself.
- 4. No playing or running.



"Love your neighbor as yourself." Class Rules 1. We always try to do our best. 2. We raise our hands before we talk. 3. We listen to our teachers. 4. We are kind to each others. 5. We Keep God's house clean.






Class Rules 1. Listen when teacher is talking 2. Raise your hand to speak 3. Follow directions 4. Sit quietly in your chair 5. Keep hands to yourself 6. Walk in the building 7. Keep God's house clean 8. Always be friendly 9. Be helpful 10. Use inside voice 11. Don't be in the room by yourself




For Churches with 50 or more Preschool & Elementary Age kids:


3. Have Parent's Rules ("responsibilities")



6. Have friendly Greeters/Bouncers

Hi Billy! Welcome to God's House!





You know my name. You acknowledge me. I will behave better.

7. Each week the teacher/shepherd greets each child by name

"the sheep recognize his voice. He calls his own sheep by name... I know my own sheep and my own sheep know me." - from John 10



8. Separate "Goof-off Friends"

"I want you buddies to learn. But you have trouble learning when you sit together. So let's try sitting separately for a month. I want to see if you can pay attention and learn better."



9. Do give Behavioral Expectations before and after each class activity.



Not fair! You always tell me how *not* to act, but you never tell me how you want me to act!"

10. Do be "prepared." Making kids wait creates discipline problems.



"Wait here, kids. I left part of my lesson in my car."




